New Puppy

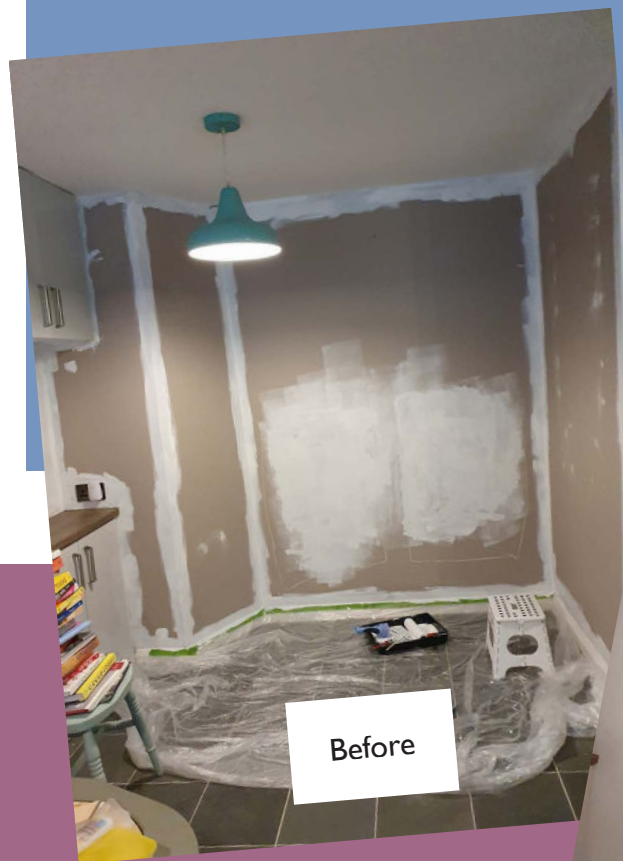
I got a puppy over the weekend, he's a golden doodle and is called Doodlebug but Dude for short. Here is a picture.

Charity Hair Cut

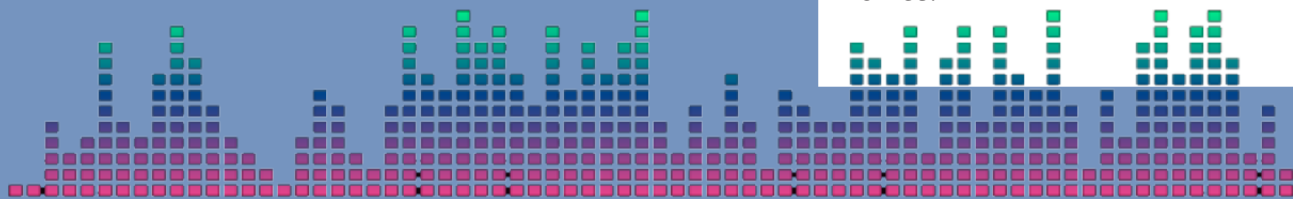
Jamie cut his long hair and donated it to the Little Princes Trust.

Radio

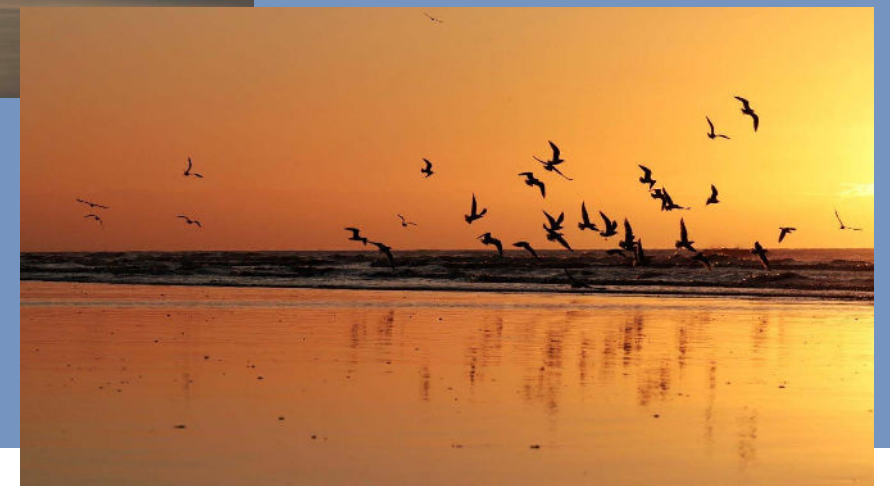
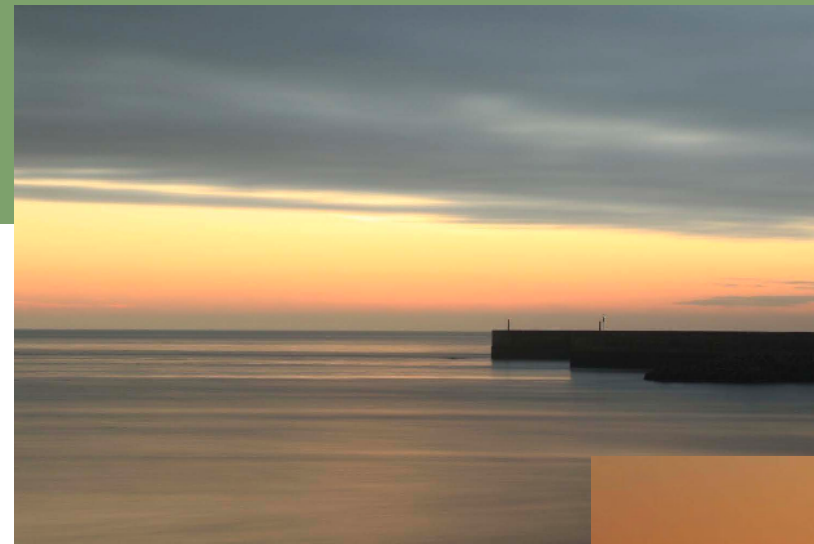
I discovered Radio 3 and have been listening to it every morning when I get into the office.

Maths

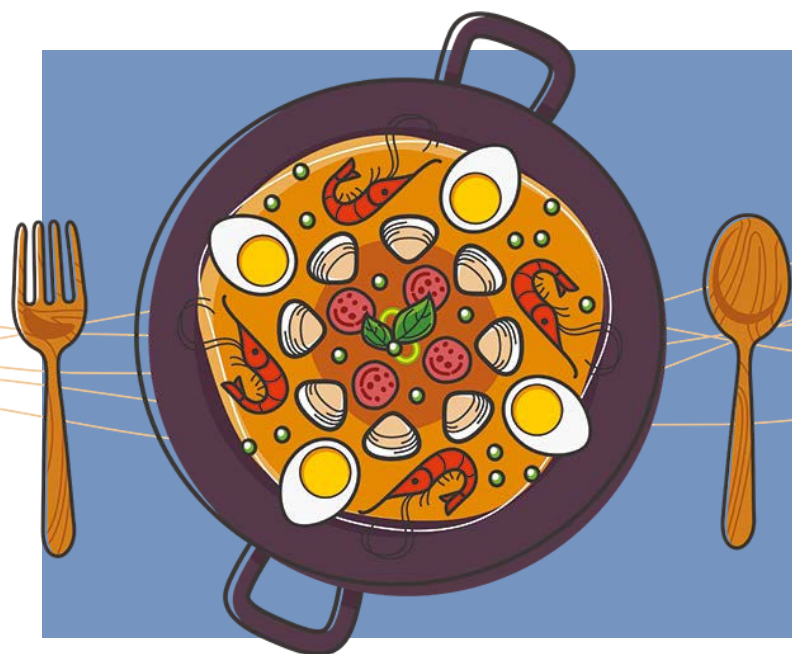
I finished a Maths challenge called The 2016 Challenge with my friend.
