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You discussed Bohunt Horsham's first ski trip - you shared some amazing feedback; saying that the trip was so well managed, appreciating the great communication between school and home before, during and after the trip.	We agreed that it was a brilliant achievement by the team and promised to share clarity over plans for next year's place allocation - in particular for those families who were unsuccessful in getting on the trip this time around.
You requested updates on the other international trips we had planned such as Florida/China.	We are meeting as a staff team to look at the feasibility of these and will update next week in the bulletin.
You discussed an offer of support with conservation on site from the 'Horsham Green Gym' group locally.	We would love support in the summer holidays with our conservation work, this would need to be organised once the final handover of the building is in place and we are really excited about the idea of having some help with our ambitious plans for making habitat on site.
You discussed the current and future travel and transport issues.	We agreed that we have shared the travel and transport survey results with the bus companies and have discussed this with them. We will write to families next week with updates.
You talked about BET Assessment results - are they shared with parents?	We reasserted our position on this - assessment results are often shared with students when papers are given back but they don't represent a useful piece of data without the ability to compare them to other students across the Trust with similar starting points which is why we assess and report progress instead, we use the BET Assessments to check our measurements of progress and to test them against the other schools and we talk about progress with students in school too.
You asked about BET Assessment revision and wondered if you could have past papers for more detailed revision.	We explained that we look at sample questions and cover revision in our DEAR Week which is always the week leading up to the assessment and, until students are in GCSE years we wouldn't expect them to have the skills and preparedness for past papers or to revise outside of DEAR Week as we don't want to put unnecessary pressure on them whilst they are still young.

You asked about the possibility of having additional Quiet Zones at lunchtime	We agreed that yes, this is needed but as a small school we don't currently have the capacity to staff any additional spaces; it's certainly something we will look at next academic year though.
You discussed the previous suggestion that the school use the Easy Fundraising process.	We have set this up and will share it in the bulletin next week. We are keen to raise funds for outdoor activities such as table tennis, chess, backgammon etc.
You noticed that there had been an increase in the number of cover lessons in school.	We agreed and pointed out that this is an issue we are aware of nationally, locally and here too.
