Bohunt Horsham: Trips and Visits

Here at Bohunt Horsham we are delighted to be able to offer your child unparalleled opportunities outside of the classroom, developing skills and knowledge from a variety of experiences and making long-lasting memories along the way. The table below is a summary of the trips and visits we currently offer, and to which year groups these apply. It is important to remember that if your child is in years 9 and 10, they can still experience many of these trips even if they link directly to a GCSE subject they are not taking. This is part of our promise to you that our students receive the opportunity to experience a wide variety of experiences outside of their curriculum.

Notification of upcoming trips / updates during trips

You will be notified of upcoming trips and visits through our parent bulletin. You receive this via the ClassCharts app. High-cost residentials are often promoted a year in advance through a parent webinar by the trip leader. Payments are made in instalments through the school gateway and you will receive letters and webinars with information leading up to the trip.

Whilst on trips and visits, you will receive important updates on ClassCharts announcements (i.e. arrival information) and we will post, when and where possible, photos of the trip using a specific Twitter/X hashtag (you don't need a Twitter/X account or app to access these, you can browse Twitter/X as a guest and search for the hashtag).

ERA Week

Each year our students are involved in 'ERA Week'. This is where timetabled lessons are collapsed and are offered a variety of opportunities that encapsulate our school ethos of 'enjoy, respect, achieve'. You will be provided with more details of ERA Week in the autumn term however an outline of potential costs are given below.
