What SEND support does Bohunt Horsham offer?



We support all students with SEND, regardless of whether they have a formal diagnosis. Most support takes place in the classroom, working with the teachers to adapt the learning and make it accessible to all students.

Why?

Getting a diagnosis is very personal. Some people do not want one and do not feel it is in their child's best interest.

We will provide support for the behaviours each child presents rather than reacting to a diagnosis.

In the second half of the first term, we also run intervention groups, 1-2-1 mentoring groups, sensory support and outdoor activities to build confidence and resilience for our students. We may invite your child to join one of the groups if we think they will benefit from attending.

Our team is growing! We are happy to announce the new role of Learning Coach to our Learning Support Assistant Team. The Learning Coaches look at supporting a range of need in the classroom, conducting observations to plan for provisions. They are currently completing their year long inductions programme to help support our students.
