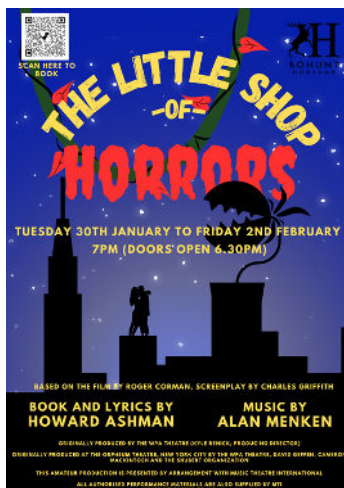

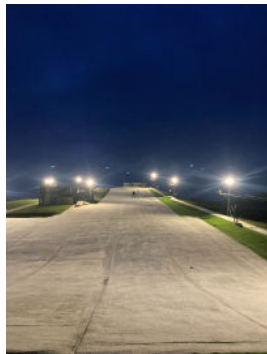

There will be plenty of bargains to be had with blazers for £10 and polo shirts at only £3.

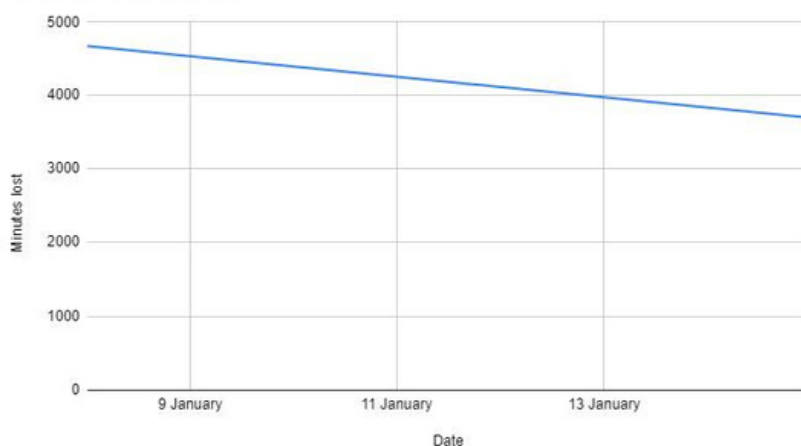

Attendance and Punctuality: An update

We are happy to inform you that our focus on punctuality is already having a positive impact. Although there is still room for improvement, we have observed a thousand-minute improvement in a week, which is a step in the right direction, as shown in the data below.

If your child has lost any minutes due to being late, you will receive information from their form tutor about it. You can also continue to monitor their attendance and punctuality through the attendance tab on ClassCharts.

This week, all staff are receiving additional SEND training to look at different ways to support students with additional needs if they struggle to concentrate. Particularly for those with ADHD or suspected ADHD. The aim of this is to improve students' skills in remaining engaged throughout a lesson. Students should not be leaving lessons if they find this a challenge, but instead, working with their teachers to see what works best for them within the classroom.

Maths Equipment

In the maths department, we have noticed that some students are attending their classes without all the necessary equipment. To help them learn effectively, we require all students to bring the following items with them to their maths lessons:

Scientific calculator (Casio fx-83GT CW)

Pen

Pencil

Ruler

Set square

Protractor

Compass,

Rubber.

After the half term, we will be conducting equipment checks and we expect to see a significant improvement in students' readiness to learn. It's important for them to have all of these items with them to understand how to use each one in maths, especially the buttons on their calculator.

Here is the latest lost property in its new home. It's much easier for the children to see and so far is proving a better system with children able to access their belongings more easily. We check the items regularly and will always try to return named items to their owners. As you can see there are lots of very expensive coats and water bottles that have been misplaced. Understand your teenager's behaviour

Teenagers' behaviour can be baffling, stressful and worrying.

Do you find it hard to understand and manage your teenager's behaviour? Would you like to improve communication, avoid conflict and learn new strategies for setting boundaries?

Horsham District Council's Community Safety team runs a free six-week course called '**Understanding Teenage Behaviour**', which has been designed to empower parents and carers to think about the behaviour of their teenager and manage it using a range of tools for improving communication, setting boundaries and putting consequences in place.

The course has been put together by a psychologist and uses a cognitive behaviour approach. Course content can be adapted to meet the needs of the parents attending.
