Horsham Foodbank



The Horsham District Foodbank continues to experience a huge demand for their services. So far this year, they have provided almost 4,500 individual food parcels. Almost 1,800 of these were for children.

Unfortunately, food donations have dropped to critically low levels, and they are desperate to raise stock levels to ensure that they can continue to meet the demand for emergency food for those struggling in our community. We are hoping you can help.

Horsham Foodbank are asking their supporters to collect food (see list below) which will then be delivered to The Bridge Leisure Centre on **Tuesday, 9th July between 9am-8pm**. The food will be lined up along the running track to make a Tin Trail, the longest line of food donations in ONE day.

A box will be in our reception until the 9th July and any donations are welcome from students and families. We will then select two students to accompany us to The Bridge on Tuesday 9th to deliver the donations for their appeal. Many thanks.

To access the foodbank provision please contact support@horsham-matters.org.uk or phone **0300 1240204**. Summer holidays can be particularly challenging with the additional expense of food and activities. For families using the foodbank they will also be able to access a children's prepacked lunch box on three specific dates to coincide with the free HDC entertainment at the bandstand in Horsham park.

To access this additional provision, families need to select one of the following dates:

23rd July
6th August
20th August

They then need to contact Horsham Matters as above providing their contact details and the number of children requiring packed lunch (as a reminder this is for families needing foodbank support). Numbers are limited on a first come first serve basis and must be booked at least a week before the session to secure their booking.
