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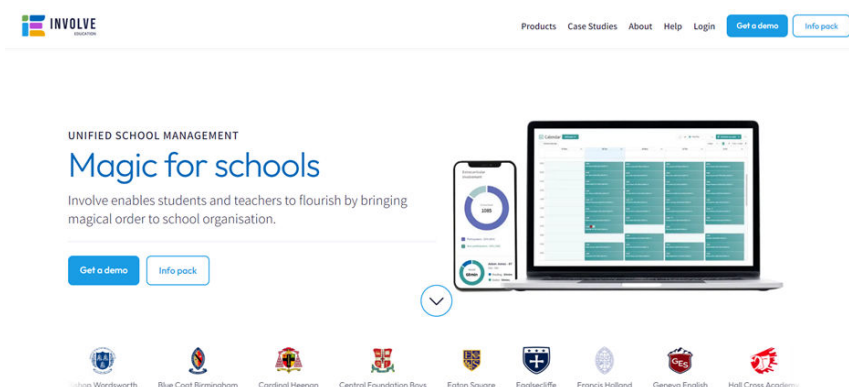
Dear Families

Once a student has logged into their Involve account they will be able to view all the clubs that are running for their year group. 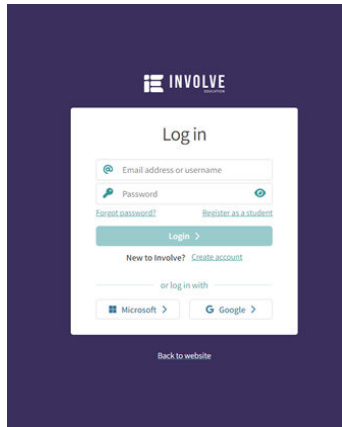
You will also be able to login to your own Involve account and view all clubs/activities that your child can join as well as track the clubs they have already registered for.

How families can access Involve

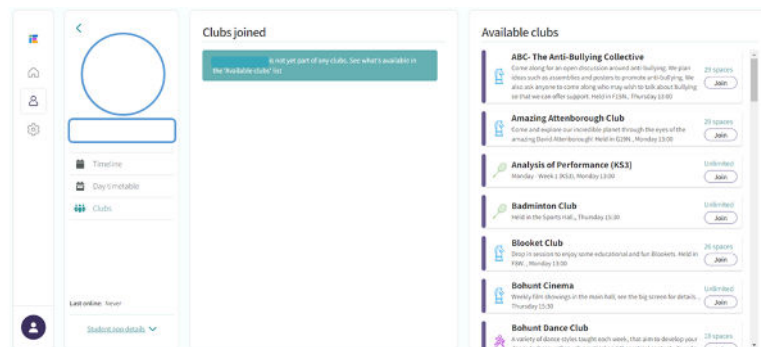
The site can be accessed either using the Involve Education App or by logging in directly on the [Involve Education Website](#)



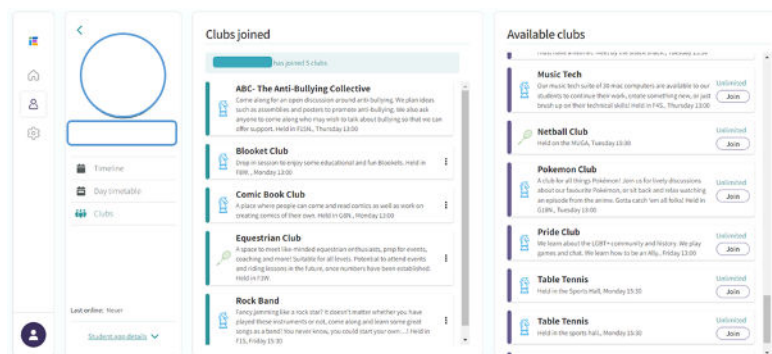
You should receive an invitation to join Involve; however if you have not, please simply select 'Create new account' and register using the email address you have provided to the school.



Once you have registered with Involve you should be able to view your child's current information. To view their current co-curricular activities please select the students icon and select clubs. This is the view you should be able to see:



All clubs that your child qualifies for will appear on the right hand side of the screen. If you would like to register your child for a club you can select 'join' and it will be added to their current clubs list. Any clubs your child has already registered for should appear in the 'clubs joined' section. Some clubs have limited spaces and these will be filled on a first come, first served basis. The current number of available spaces will be shown next to the join button for each club. Your child's schedule for the week is visible under the 'Timeline' section.

We currently have over 50 different activities that students can register for. These cover a wide range of interests including sports, gaming, reading and more! The clubs available will change each term so keep an eye out for new clubs joining the timetable.
